- Wheelchair access is an issue at YMCA and rent in South Parish is an alternative venue for Southern Area meetings. Paul J and Annmarie will look into alternative Area venues and literature office.
- An issue was brought up by a Cork member for discussion at Area. The discussion was had on do member feel their needs are being met in NA? Is there an atmosphere of recovery? Why are long term members leaving the NA Fellowship? That newcomers felt there wasn't enough old - timers & experience at meetings, meetings lacked maturity & clean time. It has been pointed out there is no forum for discussion for members to air their grievances. Also that there is not enough emphasis on the recovery program and too much emphasis on service. The member also brought up concerns at World Service level at the direction of the way NA is going, and that NA has been moved away from the original program as written in the Basic Text and It Works: How & Why. These questions came up and were discussed. In the course of the discussion the chair pointed out that while it is obviously desirable that old -timers continue to come to group meetings, willingness to attend NA meetings is a matter for the individual member. NA cannot compel any member old-timer or otherwise to show up.
